St Mary's Dilwyn Evaluation (2022)

Headlines KS1 (Based On Teacher Assessments & Test Data)

- 92% Mathematics
- 77% reading & Writing
- 77% RWM 20% plus above National Average

Headlines KS2 (Based On Test Data)

- Year 4 Mathematics Tables Check average 23.4.
- 75% Achieved Reading at the National Standard 50% at the higher level.
- 87.5% Achieved Numeracy at the National Standard 50% at the higher level.
- 87.5% Achieved Writing at the National Standard 37.5 at the higher level.
- 75% Achieved RWM at the National Standard 50% at the higher level.

This would indicate that our provision for teaching & learning during lockdown was very successful compared to National & LA (See Statistics).
